



Built in 1900, 354 Crescent Avenue is single family home with two bonus apartments, one-car garage parking, and additional driveway parking located on Bernal Heights' sunny southern slope. This building presents

a hint of Art Deco influence on a traditional Edwardian exterior. Inside there is a ton of natural light and plenty of opportunity for sophisticated upgrades with a little sweat equity.

Residents enter 354 Crescent Avenue via a covered, arched porch and a shared entryway that offers extra storage and leads to the top floor and middle units. The bright top unit will be delivered vacant while already earning income from the middle and garden units.

Entering the top floor apartment, you find a foyer with a large window and an adjacent office/reception area. The living room has views of Bernal Hill and Holly Park, skylights, and lots of built in storage, while the eat-in kitchen has high ceilings, windows on two sides, and French doors leading to a protected porch with laundry hook-ups.

The first of three bedrooms has a large window and a closet, while the second bedroom has two closets and extra built-in storage. The master bedroom has high ceilings, windows on two sides, and extra storage built over the closets. The bathroom has a shower over a tub.

The middle unit is tenant-occupied and opens onto a double parlor consisting of a living room with a bay window, high ceilings, crown moulding, a wood-burning fireplace and an ample dining room. Adjacent to the dining room is a sunny eat-in kitchen.

The master bedroom has two closets and windows on two sides, while the separated second bedroom has views of the back garden and parquet flooring. The bathroom has a shower over a tub and a window.

The ground floor inlaw apartment is also tenant-occupied and offers two bedrooms, a living room, and a bathroom with a shower over a tub along with an eat-in kitchen and direct access to the back garden.

354 Crescent Avenue works well for owner-occupants looking for additional income or investors looking for a rental property in the desirable Bernal Heights' neighborhood.
